- Directions** The event centre will be the Riverdene pub, post code RG21 4BY & GR SU647521. Exit the M3 at Junction 6 and locate Assembly off London Rd. The parking area at the pub is limited, so you may have to find alternative parking nearby in the residential area, taking care not to utilise signed private areas.
- Map/Areas:** 1:5,000 on double-sided A4 waterproof paper, 5m contours, covering Western and Eastern aspects. The entire area consists of the War Memorial Park, combined with the urban Black Dam estate and Crabtree Plantation (contains woodland). All sectors linked by several underpasses, providing plenty of route choice (e.g. to cross under the Ring Road). Both sides of the map are linked via the MANDATORY M3 Junction 6 access road underpass.
- Courses:** 1 hour normal score event, as per guidelines. 29 Controls with various point scores. Control Descriptions will be printed on the East side of map and will be available separately at Registration. N.B. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.  
Punching start (within 100m, south of London Rd), just turn up, register & go!  
EMIT eCards will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download afterwards!!
- Times:** Registration: - 18:15 to 19:00 – this will take place in the pub.  
Starts: - 18:30 to 19:15  
Courses close: - promptly at 20:15 please. We don't wish to organise a search....
- Entry:** EOD only (however please email [urban@bado.org.uk](mailto:urban@bado.org.uk) to reserve a map or use online registration link), especially if you want some food (see below).

EMIT Card Hire:- Seniors £1.50 Juniors free.  
Lost Cards will be charged at £45.
- Facilities:** Toilets in pub, limited First Aid, Publican has offered to provide Spaghetti Bolognese food option **only if booked** in advance when reserving a map. Usual pub drinks obviously available.
- Safety:** All competitors **must** wear hi-viz tops & have **sufficient** lights to complete their course (take a back up!). No road crossings will be manned so please take care, Use of all of the several Underpasses are mandatory. Course/Points/safety details will be available on the night.
